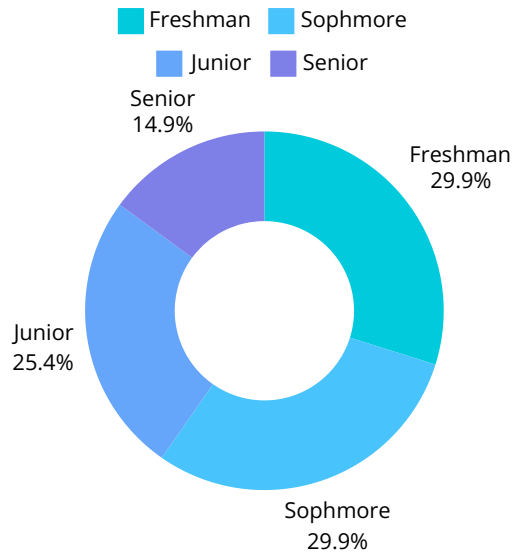

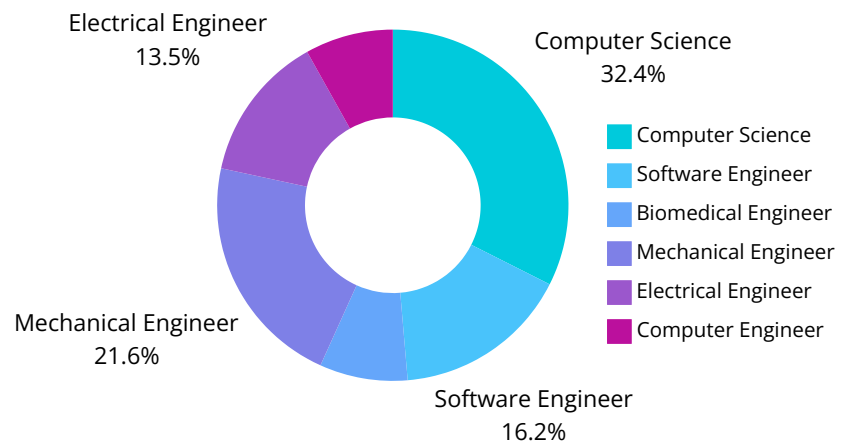

BY YEAR

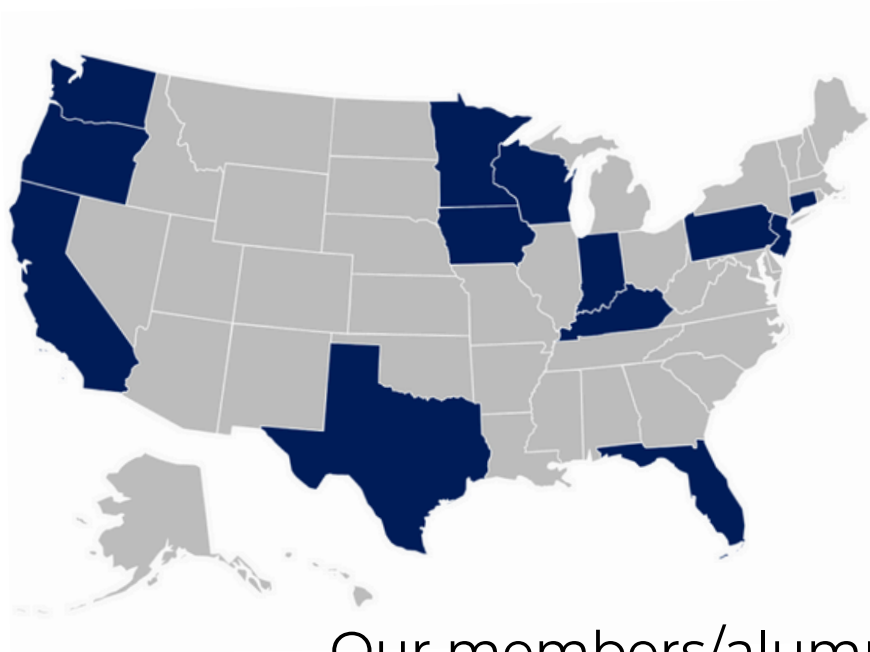


BY MAJOR

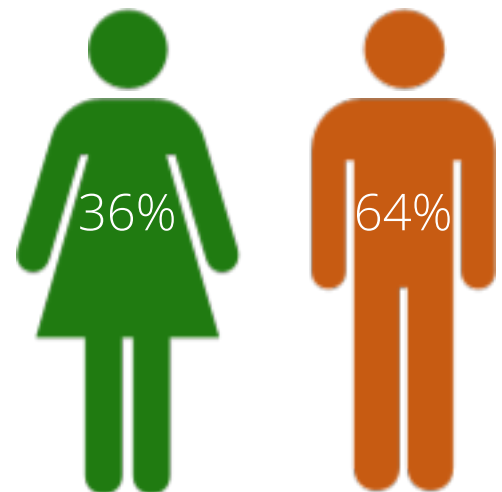
